Dear Ms. Reyes:

The Department is pleased to announce that your company has been certified as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) which is subject to continued eligibility and also subject to actions of any other governmental agencies which may affect the minority status of your firm. This agency certification enables the company to compete for Department work as a minority owned and operated company. It is not a guarantee that the company will receive work.

DBE certification by the Department shall be for a period of three (3) years. On each anniversary date during the three (3) year certification period an Affidavit For Continuing Eligibility must be submitted. If at any time there is a change in the ownership and control of the company, a new Uniform Certification Program Application is to be forwarded without delay to the Department. For recertification at the end of the three (3) year period a new Uniform Certification Program Application must be submitted to the Department ninety (90) days prior to expiration of your current certification.

Your firm can participate in FDOT contracts for DBE credit in the following specialty codes: 942-Electrical Engineering Services, 945-Mechanical Engineering Services, and 947-CADD Services.
